FORMAL PROCEEDINGS

All guests will be invited at approximately 11.50am to take their position for viewing the formal proceedings in the area in front of the Restaurant. In the event of wet weather these proceedings will take place in the Delapré Studio.

LUNCHEON

Following the unveiling, HRH's party will proceed on a tour as outlined in the programme. Guests are invited to return to the Sunley Management Centre to view an exhibition and take drinks in the William Shapland Theatre. Luncheon will be served at approximately 1.00pm, after the return of HRH from the tour.

DEPARTURE

HRH is expected to leave between 2pm and 2.30pm. Following his departure formal security arrangements will be relaxed and guests will be free to leave.
