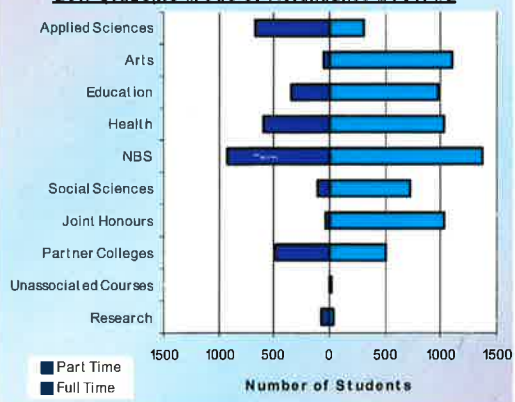

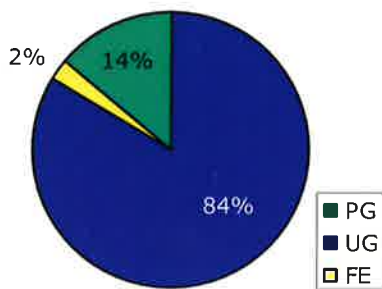

Qualifications Studied (Full and Part-time)



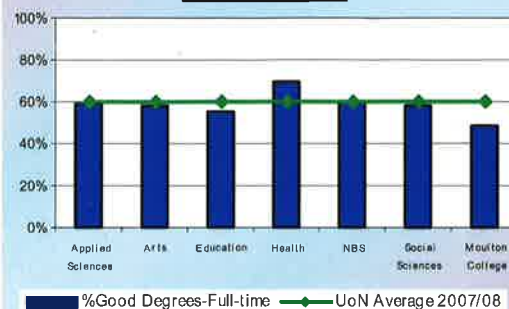
- 7.2% of full-time students and 4.5% of part-time students state that they have some form of disability (2007/08).
- 27.7% of full-time students and 14.5% of part-time students come from Black and Minority Ethnic communities (2007/08).
- 89.7% of full-time students and 96% of part-time students come from Home/EU countries (2007/08).

## Retention

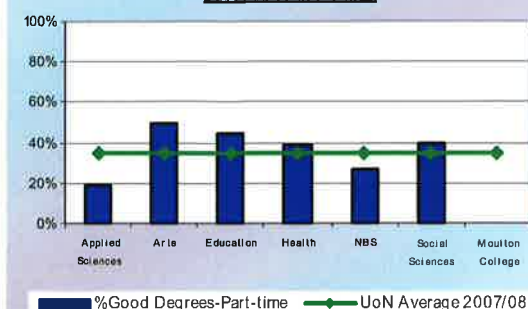
- The University of Northampton retained 92.7% of full-time students in 2007/08, up slightly from 92.3% in 2006/07.
- 92.8% of part-time students were retained in 2007/08, up slightly from 92% in 2006/07.

Undergraduate Degrees - % of Good Degrees 2007/08 (Part-time)



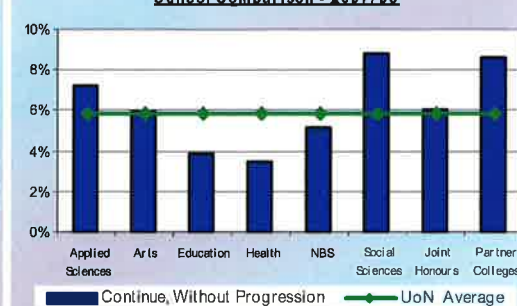
- 59.9% of full-time undergraduates were awarded a "good" degree (1st or 2:1) in 2007/08. This is the equivalent of 908 "good" degrees awarded out of 1515.
- 35% of part-time undergraduates were awarded a "good" degree (1st or 2:1) in 2007/08. This is the equivalent of 52 "good" degrees awarded out of 148.5.

Progressed to Next Stage School Comparison - 2007/08



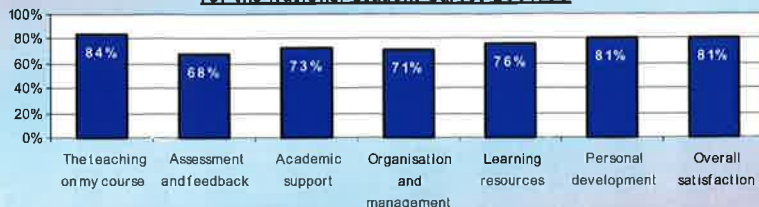
Continued Without Progression to Next Stage School Comparison - 2007/08



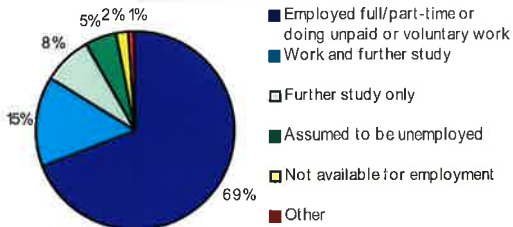
- 75.1% of full-time undergraduate students progressed on to the next stage of study from stage one to stage two from 2007/08 to 2008/09. This is the equivalent of 2099 students out of 2675.
- 5.8% of full-time undergraduate students continued to study without progression from 2007/08 to 2008/09 with students returning either full or part-time to continue on course stage one. This is the equivalent of 156 students out of 2675.

Percentage of students who agree by section for the National Student Survey 2007/08



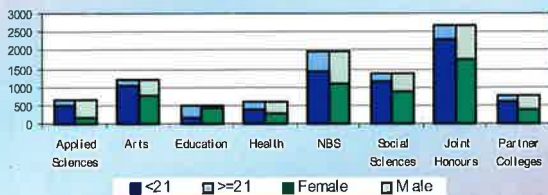
Destination of Leavers from Higher Education 2006/07



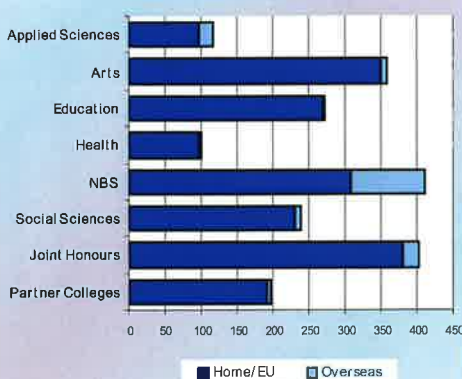
- The DLHE results show that 92% of leavers who supplied data were in work or study (or both).
- There were 2432 eligible leavers in 2006/07 of whom 1822 (75%) leavers supplied their information (This does not include those leavers who gave an explicit refusal to take part in the survey).

- Of the full-time undergraduate applications received for HEFCE funded courses, 77.4% of applicants were under 21 years of age and 22.6% were 21 and over. 59.5% were female and 40.5% were male.
- Of the total number of applications accepted for full-time undergraduate courses (funded by HEFCE), 90.2% are home/EU students and the remaining 9.8% are from overseas/other.
